Response:

My inquiry asks: How can someone without a mental illness effectively convey the perspective of individuals with different mental illnesses through art? I started by exploring trauma, including PTSD and trauma abuse, then expanded my focus to mental illnesses, ultimately narrowing to OCD. I wanted to signify the harmful impacts of stereotyping mental health and express their perspectives in a symbolic and surreal way. Illustrating the emotional depth and impactful struggles of those affected, rather than conveying OCD in a surface-level way.

Describe ways your sustained investigation developed through practice, experimentation, and revision.

Response:

I practiced with coffee to create a sepia background for an experience like trauma(1). Image 3-4 is a practice for a layered composition of abuse trauma, which I experimented in IbisPaint to create my revised piece(5). Images 6-7 I experimented with alcohol markers w/ ink, but revised it to practice with white charcoal and experiment with inverted colors to create 8. I narrowed my focus to OCD on 9. I experimented with mixing soap and watercolor to add texture and practiced w/ gouache for 11. 15 is a revision of 13 with experimenting with rubbing alcohol to create a distorted look in my piece.

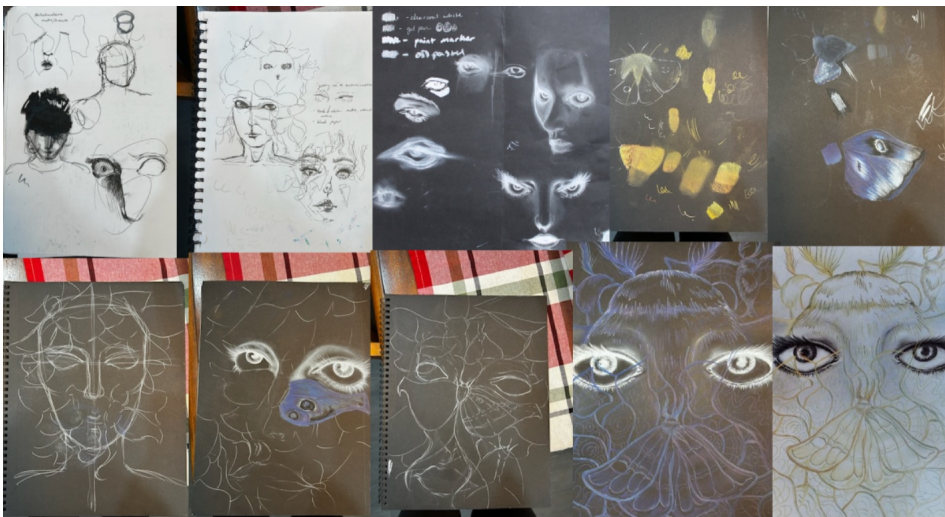

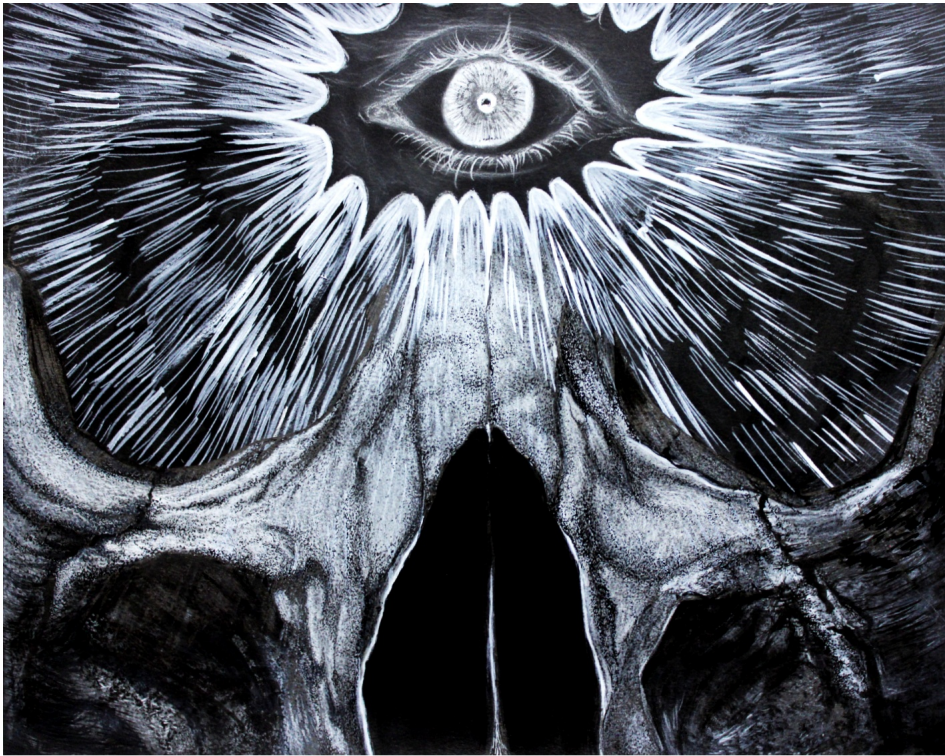

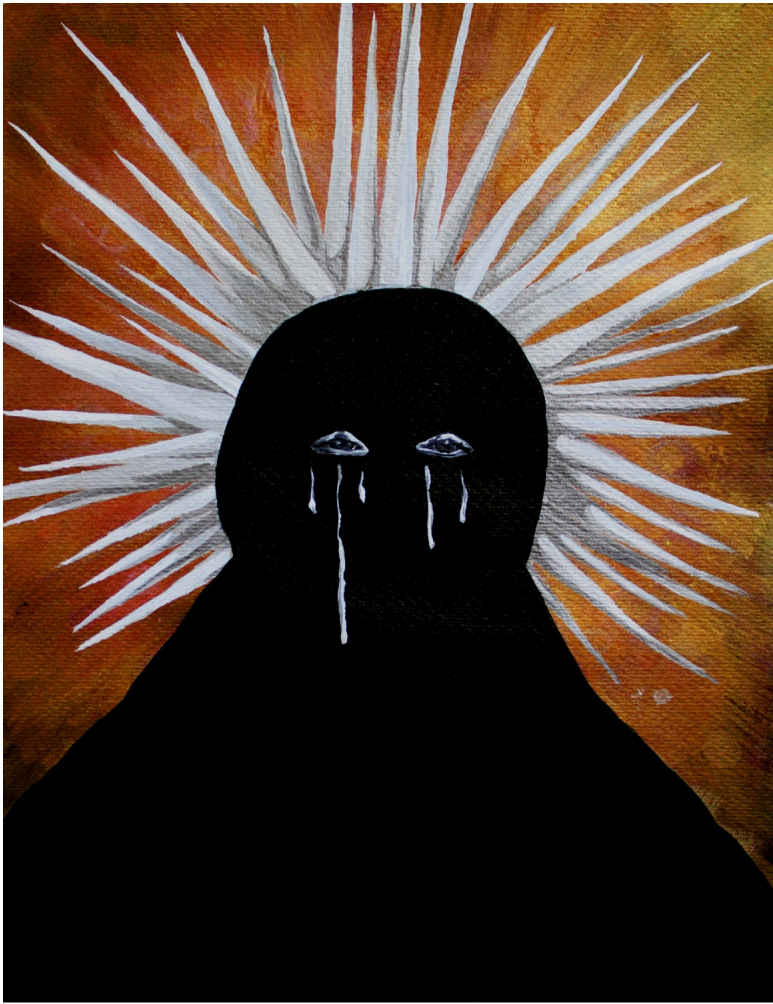
